COURSE DESCRIPTION: An introduction to the Biblical Aramaic language of the Old Testament.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- 1. To glorify God by and while learning to read the Old Testament in its original language.
- 2. To enable the student to read and translate from portions of the Aramaic Old Testament.
- 3. To aid the student in the preparation of teaching the Scriptures.
- 4. To equip the student to understand lexical aids and commentaries on the Old Testament.

REQUIREMENTS:

Class preparation: Students are required to prepare the assigned section **BEFORE in-person** sessions each week. Students should prepare the text using both Vance *et al* and Cook as aids. Students should come prepared to read the text out loud and discuss areas of translation and grammatical questions.

Attendance: Students are required to attend class sessions with the professor each Thursday. If you know you cannot make it to a class session, you must notify the instructor **in advance**. Failure to attend a significant number of classes (with "significant" being defined at the discretion of the instructor) may result in a grade reduction or failure of the class.

Quizzes: Students will have three quizzes covering important paradigms, parsing, and vocabulary from the Biblical Aramaic corpus.

Final: There will be a take-home final exam covering the Aramaic portions of the Old Testament covered in this class. Students will be responsible for parsing, vocabulary, and analysis of the text.

TOTAL GRADE:

The final grade for the course will be the total of each of the required assignments listed above.
